Children continue to enjoy the final prize of a free paperback book, made possible by a generous donation from the Friends of the Anaheim Public Library. The Friends' donation also made it possible to hire quality performers for our six special programs, as well as purchase reading incentive prizes and promotional items. Local businesses contributed reading incentive prizes, including 300 coupons from Carl's Jr., 200 coupons from Islands, 300 coupons from Rainforest Café, and 300 Legoland coupons. Helping us out with the implementation of the Summer Reading Program were 36 teen volunteers who volunteered for a total of 350 hours.
